Renu Devi is a prominent senior BJP leader in Bihar, recognized for her extensive legislative experience and her historic role as the state's first female Deputy Chief Minister (2020-2022). As of late 2025, she has secured her position as a six-time MLA from the Bettiah constituency, cementing her stronghold in West Champaran.

KEY HIGHLIGHTS



- **Sixth Consecutive Election Win (2025):** Renu Devi secured a decisive victory in the 2025 Bihar Assembly elections for the Bettiah seat, defeating Congress's Washi Ahmad with over 90,000 votes.
- **Continued NDA Leadership:** Following the 2025 victory, she remained a key figure within the Bihar BJP legislative party, although she was not included in the immediate, subsequent cabinet expansion in November 2025.
- **Grassroots Engagement (2026):** As of March 2026, she is actively participating in community engagement and religious events, including visiting the Shri BhagyaLaxmi Mandir.

Served as one of the two Deputy Chief Ministers in the NDA government, handling critical portfolios such as Panchayati Raj, Disaster Management, and Backward Class Welfare.
